Important Points to Note:

- 1. 6th grade was moved to the Junior School in the fall of 2014 (See above verticle line). The reason for the move was due to class room space becoming an issue at Crosby, Harrison Elementary and Whitewater Valley Elementary. We had classroom space at HJS to make the move happen at the time. Since moving our 6th graders out to HJS each elementary has not only replaced the enrollment void, but has surpassed that with additional students.
- 2. As of Sept. 1, 2017 we have 6 trailer classrooms at HJS that are full all day long, as well as 4 additional JS classrooms at the High School. We have 4 trailer classrooms at Crosby Elem. that are full all day. WWV has no empty classrooms and HE has 2 classrooms being used for support services. We are packed to the gills throughout the district. We are running out of room quickly! And more than 900+ new homes will be built in the next 5 years!
