## Course Change Policy

- NO changes in course selection will be made after the last day of school!!!!! (this includes adding/dropping study halls)
- All students will be given their schedule before school is released (usually first week of May)
- After May 29, 2025, NO changes can be made to either semester.

## College Credit Plus

- Any student who is wanting to be eligible for college credit must complete the following:
  - Students new to CCP need to attend an informational meeting with a parent/guardian
  - Student/Parnet must sign a letter of intent by April 1st
  - Students must apply and be accepted for student status at the individual college by that college's deadline (May 1<sup>st</sup> is the application deadline for any college classes the student is taking on Harrison High School campus)
  - Students must register for the individual classes by the college's deadline.

### New Course Offerings

- American Sign Language 4 (full year)
- CCP English College Writing (full year) JUNIORS added
- CCP Spanish 1 & 2 (semesters) must successfully complete Spanish 4
- Single and Double Bell Late Start (full year) Seniors only who have 3.5 or less credits needed for graduation
- Cybersecurity (full year)
- UC Early IT Program changed to CCP

### Handouts on Your Way Out

- Letter of Intent (for CCP students only....must be turned in by April 1<sup>st</sup>)
- College Credit Plus Application Guide (only for students taking CCP classes AT the high school. This will help guide you on what schools you need to apply to for the CCP classes you are taking)
- Yearbook application
- Business, Biomed, Engineering application (only for 9<sup>th</sup> grade students not currently in the program)
- Academic Honors Diploma Application (for students interested in obtaining an Honors diploma)

#### **Common Registration Questions**



- How many classes do I need to sign up for?
  - · A FULL schedule (7 bells)
- Do I need a foreign language to graduate?
  - No, but colleges recommend or require 2 years of the SAME language.
- What if I applied to go to Diamond Oaks next year?
  - You still need to register normally for a full schedule! Then we will remove your requests once you have officially been accepted.

#### **Common Registration Questions**

- Do I have to take the AP test if I have an AP class?
  - Yes. You will be charged for the test through your school fees at the beginning of the year.
- Can I schedule a Study Hall?
  - No (Study Hall may be scheduled for you as needed, after you receive your schedule, you can contact your counselor before May 29<sup>th</sup> to add a study hall)
- Can I retake a class that I have already passed?
  - At this time, the only classes that are available for duplicate credit are Band, Choir, Contemporary World Issues, Journalism, Yearbook, and TV Production & Broadcast.
