# Registration Process

- Students receive materials for Registration during school– 1/30/2025
- Students fill out Registration forms with their parents & teachers by 2/4/2025
- Each student needs to register for 7 bells!

# Registration Process

- Elective classes to consider
  - Band
  - Art 1
  - Choir
  - World Language (need to be enrolled in English 9CP or English 9Adv to take Spanish 1)
  - Other electives offered- if your program requires an application, it must be turned in with your registration sheet.
  - If student is choosing PE exemption, they must have the PE Exemption Parent Form completed and with them at registration.

# Registration Process



- Students have current teachers sign what classes they are recommended to take 1/30/25-2/3/25
- Please remember that NCAA Eligibility Center courses must be college prep classes or honors to meet eligibility standards.
- Students meet with a counselor one-on-one to go over their class choices. (2/4 and 2/5)

# Petition to Upgrade

➤ If the parent does not agree with course recommendations, students can submit a "Petition to Upgrade" (for most classes) when they meet with the HS counselor. "Petition to Upgrade" forms can be found in the Jr School guidance office or you can print one at home.

# Graduation Requirements 2029

#### FIRST, cover the credits

Students must earn a minumum of 21 credits in specified subjects and take all required End of Course (AIR) exams.

#### SECOND, show competency

Students must earn a passing score on Ohio's high school End of Course (AIR) Algebra 1 and English II tests.\*

\*Students that do not achieve competency scores after 2 tries will be redirected to alternative pathways to graduation by their Guidance counselor

#### THIRD, show readiness

# **Open Enrollment District**

- Southwest Local Schools is an Open Enrollment District
- Open Enrollment applications must be submitted to the Superintendent of Schools between May 1 and May 31.
- Interviews with the Superintendent will take place in June
- Freshman Open Enrollment students do not lose a year of eligibility from interscholastic sports.
