

State-Funded Junior ACT Opt-Out Form

Sign & Return ONLY if opting out

The Ohio Department of Education and Workforce, under Ohio Revised Code 3301.072, requires all high school Juniors to take the state-funded ACT or SAT college readiness examination. Recognizing that not all students will enter a 2- or 4-year college or university right after graduation and that some students may have already taken one of these assessments during high school, ODEW has created an opt-out option for families to exempt their high school junior from taking the state-mandated test. This opt-out option begins with the Class of 2026.
