1. **All students must come in-person on June 3rd from 8:00-9:00 for computer pick-up. Financial literacy students can leave that day after picking up their computer.**
 - a. Health and financial literacy students must log on for a minimum of 2 hours each day from home per enrolled course until the course is complete.
2. All students must **return their computers by Friday, 6/28** by at 10:00 am.
3. **HEALTH ONLY: Required in-person June 3rd: 11:00-1:30.**
 - a. **Computer pick-up for Health students only is 11:00-11:30 am June 3rd.**
 - b. CPR Presentation/General Certification **June 3rd, 11:30-12:30, Erin's Law 12:30-1:30.**

c. **It is mandatory that all students enrolled in Summer School Health appear in-person this day to meet all course requirements. **Students not in attendance will not receive credit for the course.** Parents may choose to opt their child out of the Erin's Law component.
